



Latin American Studies Graduate Fellowship Award, 2022-23

Description

University of Toronto doctoral students who are in the writing stage of their dissertation are encouraged to apply for a Graduate Fellowship Award supported by the Latin American Studies program in the Department of Spanish & Portuguese.

The LAS Graduate Fellowship Award is valued at \$1,000 CAD and is for one full academic year (September 1 – May 30). LAS Graduate Fellows will be expected to engage with students and the larger intellectual community at Latin American Studies. They will give an academic seminar related to their research and will also contribute one workshop for undergraduate students on a topic of interest, mutually agreed with the Associate Chair of Latin American Studies.

Applications must include:

- a one-page cover letter outlining their qualifications for the Latin American Studies Graduate Fellowship;
- a brief, general description of three workshops the applicant could potentially lead for undergraduate students (approx. 150 words per topic);
- a curriculum vitae;
- a one-page summary of their doctoral thesis and progress to date;
- a letter of recommendation from their dissertation supervisor.

LAS Graduate Fellows must be currently registered University of Toronto graduate students in the year the fellowship is held. They are expected to attend and participate in the Latin American Studies programming during the tenure of their award.

Deadline for application is August 22, 2022. Award will be announced by September 9, 2022.

To apply, compile all documentation requested (except letter of recommendation) in a single pdf and send by email to las.program@utoronto.ca, to the attention of the LAS Advisory Board. Applicants must name the file “LAS GFA 2022 *Your Last Name*” and use the same convention as the subject of the application email. Dissertation supervisors should forward their letter of recommendation to the same email address by the deadline.
